Title	A Proposition to Modify the Faculty Senate Constitution to Include Nontenure-Track Faculty Representation on the Senate Leadership Committee

Proposal

It is proposed to modify the NMSU Faculty Senate Constitution to explicitly include Non-tenure Track Faculty Representation on the Senate Leadership Committee

Proposed additions to the policy (given in **red font**) and proposed deletions to the policy (given in **red strikethrough font**) are shown below:

ARTICLE VI – OFFICERS

Section A: The **seven eight** senate electing groups are:

- (1) the **four** senators representing the four community colleges;
- (2) the senator representing the university Library and the senators representing the College of Arts and Sciences;
- (3) the three senators representing the Cooperative Extension Service, the senators representing the College of Agricultural, Consumer, and Environmental Sciences **and the Agriculture Experiment Station;**
- (4) the 6 senators representing the nontenure-track faculty;**
- (5) the senators representing ~~each of the remaining colleges~~ the College of Business;**
- (6) the senators representing the College of Education;**
- (7) the senators representing the College of Engineering; and**
- (8) the senators representing Health and Social Services**

Each of the above shall each constitute ~~a~~ separate senate electing groups.

Sections B, C, and D shall remain unchanged.

Rationale

This change corrects an oversight in previous versions of the Faculty Senate Constitution and now explicitly includes the non-tenure track senators as members of the Senate Leadership Committee by defining them as one of the senate's electing groups.
