| N. Grijalva presented the Panopto and Adobe Connect Data Life Cycle. Increase in number of recordings. N. Grijalva wants to tie life cycle to courses at 2 years and 1 week. She is interested in the number of faculty who re-use courses. Over 2,000 sessions are currently archived. Working both on academic and administrative side. K. Brook asked what a faculty member would have to do to retain it. N. Grijalva answered that some sessions have never been viewed. If approved, more information will be going out about what to do. K. Brook would like faculty input and then discuss further with N. Grijalva at next ADAC meeting. B. Pollack stated concern about faculty who only teach every other year. In conclusion, Grijalva said that the same recommendation to archive has already been taken to FACT. | | |

Associate Deans will be asked to provide feedback on assurance argument in the second half of July. Discussion on how we calculate credit hours and how our DE courses are equivalent. Also, with compressed courses, how do we ensure that students are getting the same level/quality of instruction/outcomes. T. Ketelaar gave an update on Academic Integrity. The workgroup will get back on track and revisit the policy draft after finals week. | | |
| | ACES Range Science an Animal Science Degrees to 120 | |
| J. Hawkes presented two programs that ACES would like to adjust credits down to 120 credits through electives: Range Science and Animal Science. Kori Plank is updating the catalog as 120 degree changes come in. Signatures will still be needed. | | |

Transfer Credit Committee Update

Dept. of course prefix will continue to be the "owner" / decider

Level 1 is statewide general education curriculum

Level 2 NMSU (faculty-established) course-by-course transfer equivalency

Level 3 is specific program articulation between an NMSU program/dept. and a program/dept. at another institution, monitored at the department program level, in accordance with articulation agreement.

D. Sedillo and S. Stovall will continue work on transfer issues with the goal being to achieve consistency. Work on an e-form is underway.

Per S. Cooper, tracking is always an issue. D. Sedillo said that her staff will know if an evaluation is in progress. D. Sedillo said that ideally, there would be standard degree plans across campus with exceptions, workflows being identified and established.
