Effective immediately, all staff working on academic data-related activities in the Office of Information Technology, Office of Academic Affairs, and NMSU-Global will join the Office of Institutional Analysis (OIA) as one Office to serve as single source of truth, and to bring consistency and quality in data development, analyses, and reporting. I am pleased to announce that Dr. Gabe V. Garcia has been selected as the Provost Fellow to oversee this consolidation, bring clarity to the roles and responsibilities of staff, and improve operational efficiencies.
