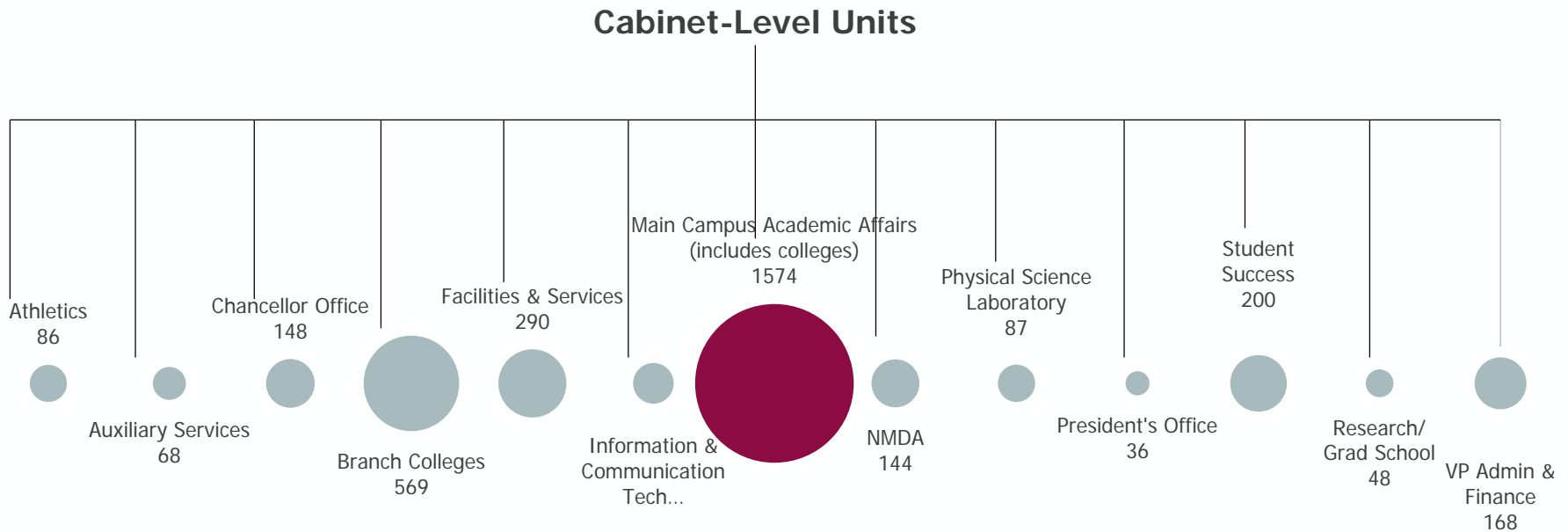

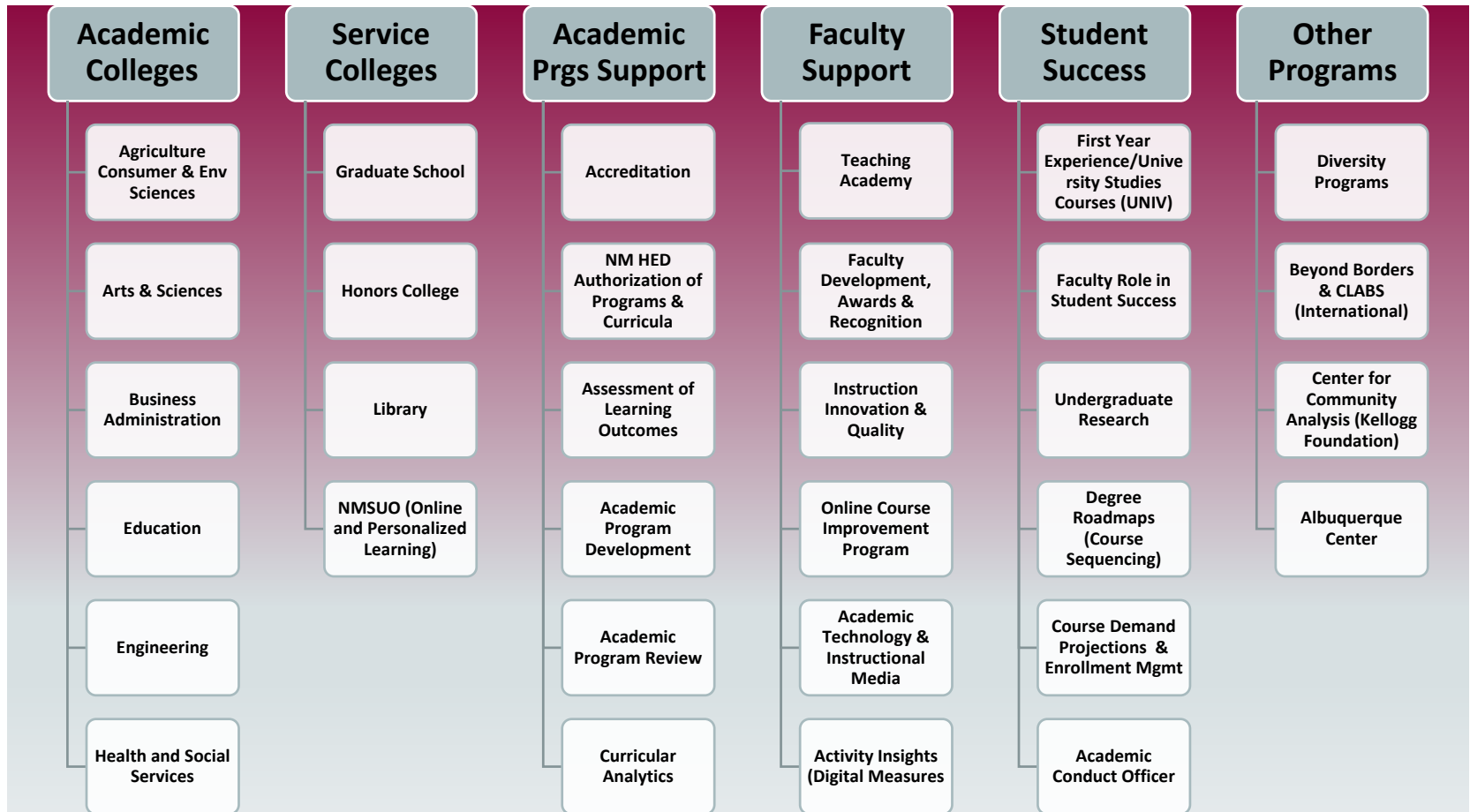
Academic Affairs Responsibilities

- Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost
 - *Chief Academic Officer for the NMSU system*
- Supervises University academic deans and VPAA program directors
- Policy development and implementation guidance for academic personnel
 - *Recruitment, hiring, credentialing, compensation, professional development, retention initiatives, and performance review of faculty members*
- Academic unit organization and administration, program and curriculum development, program review, accreditation, state authorization
- Integrity and development of teaching methods (pedagogy)
- Student and program learning outcomes assessment
- Establishment of academic agreements with external partners, e.g., Burrell COM
 - *academic affiliations, clinical placements, credit transfer agreements, etc.*
- Compliance with related Federal and State mandates, reporting requirements
- Faculty Senate and ASNMSU liaison roles
- Student Success and Enrollment Management collaboration with VPSS
- Research mission collaboration with VPR
- Diversity, equity and inclusion collaboration with VP for Equity and Inclusion

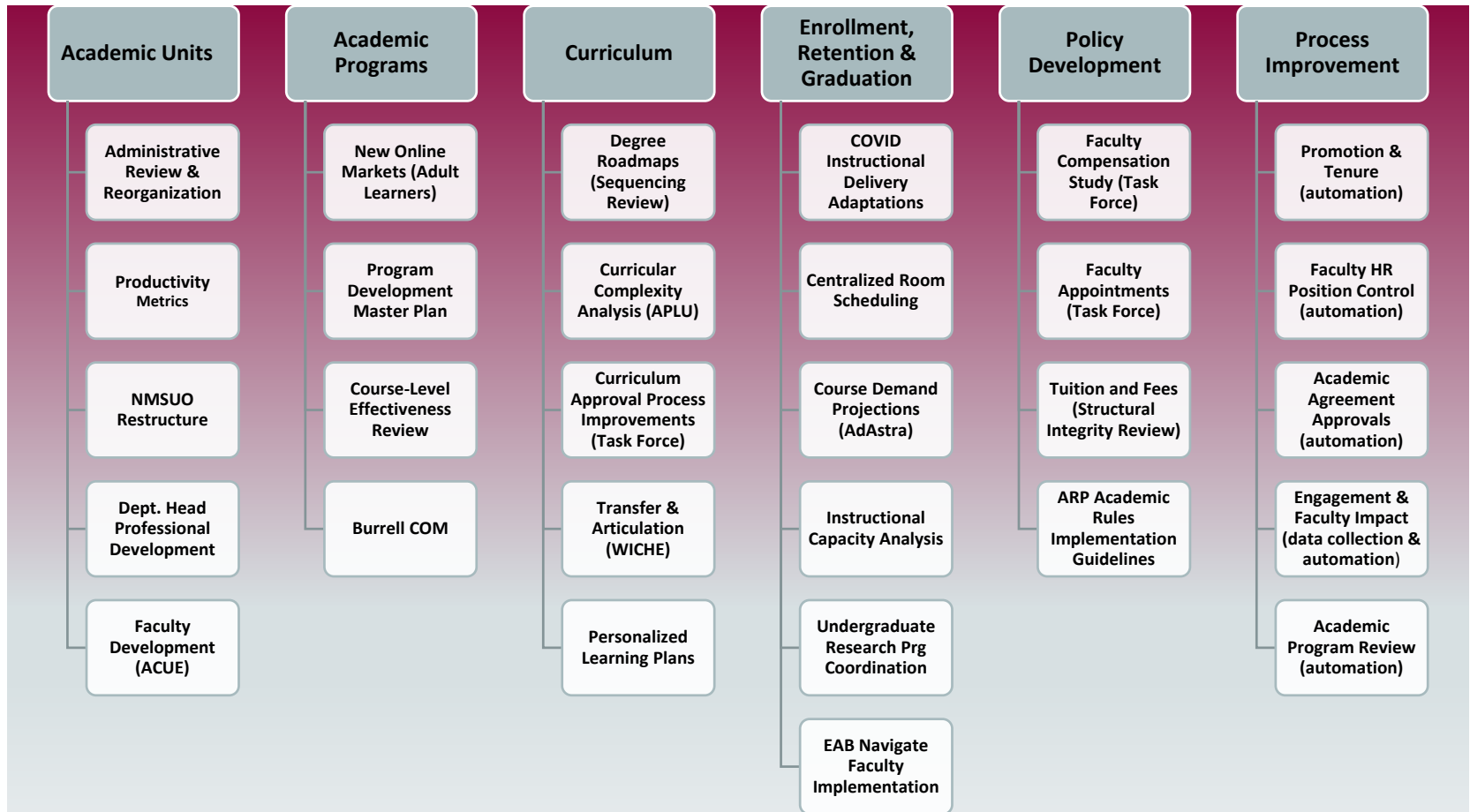
FY20-21 Faculty and Staff Headcount by Division (regular full-time employees only)

“faculty, board members, and administrators actively engage to share responsibility for identifying and pursuing an aligned set of mission-driven sustainable outcomes and priorities”

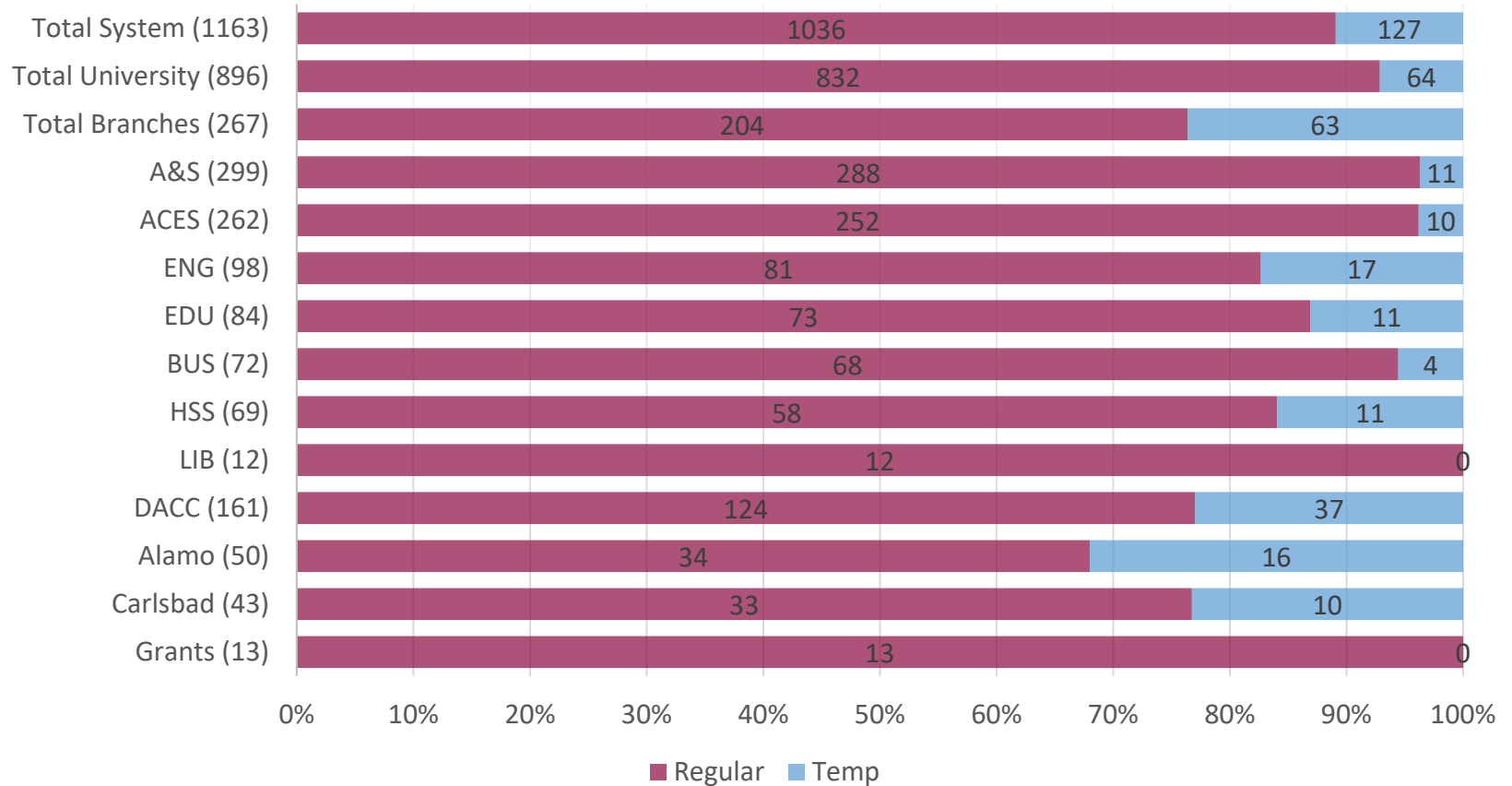
